At Barristers we strive to bring you an interesting and ever-changing wine list for your enjoyment. We source new and different wines on a frequent basis – giving you an opportunity to taste unusual or unknown wines. Our aim is to be able to offer a wine list which is comprehensive, and yet not intimidating, never boring, and yet presents wine choices for all occasions.

## WINE PROMOTION

We regularly promote new wines at our Wednesday Evening Wine Tastings where you can experience a taste of a wide range of new wines for free. From time to time, we do negotiate special deals with wine estates which we are able to pass on to our Customers and suggest that you ask your waiter/waitress for details of current wine specials.

## WINE BY THE GLASS

To enable you to experience and enjoy different wines, we serve many of our wines by the glass. The serving per glass is a generous 250ml which is equivalent to a third of a normal bottle. We also include the nominal Alcohol By Volume (ABV) levels of all our wines on the wine list. These are taken off the label of wines we have in stock and should be regarded as a guide only, as they may vary from vintage to vintage.

## CORKAGE

If you are eating in the Restaurant and wish to bring your own wine with you, we do not charge corkage on your first bottle of wine; thereafter we are obliged to ask corkage R35 per bottle. In the Bar, Cafe, Courtyard or Deck areas which operate as our Bar/Pub Area, we do not allow any ‘bring your own’ beverages for on-premise consumption for obvious reasons.

We can, and do, arrange special corkage agreements for private functions, particularly 21<sup>st</sup>, 40<sup>th</sup>, 50<sup>th</sup> and any birthday parties after 60.

# CHAMPAGNE & SPARKLING WINES

## Champagne

375ml 750ml

### **Drappier Carte d'Or** (ABV 12.0%)

R370 R595

Rich and golden with a bouquet of sweet briar, stoned fruit and a spicy hint ensures a finish of great length.

### **Lallier Rose Premier Cru** (ABV 12.0%)

R760

Elegant and charming red-fruit flavours with a touch of wild strawberry. This lively champagne has a unique bouquet and gorgeous colour

## Sparkling Wines - Methode Cap Classique

175ml 750ml

### **Villiera Tradition Brut - Paarl** (ABV 12.0%)

R165

A wine with soft, perfumed aromas, full-fattish fruit, lifted by a soft mousse of small bubbles.

### **Simonsig Brut Rose - Stellenbosch** (ABV 13.5%)

R165

A delightful bright, rosy-pink colour. The mousse is fine and enthusiastic and brings out the floral and yeasty aromas in the mouth.

### **Pierre Jourdan Brut - Franschhoek** (ABV 12.0%)

R34 R175

The lime characteristics of the Chardonnay predominate but are well supported by the Pinot Noir. This MCC is crisp, stimulating and rewarding on the palate.

### **Graham Beck Brut Rose - Franschhoek** (ABV 12.0%)

R175

This wine has a beautiful salmon-pink colour with strawberry-fruit flavours.

### **Krone Borealis Cuvee Brut - Twee Jonge Gezellen, Tulbagh** (ABV 12.0%)

R175

Elegant, classic, biscuit bouquet, with yeasty lees - creaminess and fine persistent bubble.

### **Krone Rosé Cuvee Brut - Twee Jonge Gezellen, Tulbagh** (ABV 12.0%)

R195

Delicate berry fruits; elegant yeastiness with a fine, cream mousse.

### **Steenberg 1682 - Constantia** (ABV 11.5%)

R225

The Brut 1682 yields a consistent flavour of fresh, Granny Smith apples with overtones of freshly-baked biscuits rounded by a creamy, yet fresh mouth feel.

### **Robertson Sparkling Doux - Non Alcoholic** (ABV 0.0%)

R65

This semi-sweet, alcohol-free sparkling is full of delicate fruit, bubbles and sunshine.

# WHITE WINES

## Sauvignon Blanc

175ml 750ml

### Robertson Sauvignon Blanc - Robertson (ABV 12.5%)

R25 R70

Our House Wine, which is chosen to be consumed by the glass, with special friends who are able to listen when you need to review a dreary day's work.

### Splattered Toad - Noordhoek, Cape Point (ABV 13.0%)

R30 R85

Dedicated to saving the Leopard Toad of Noordhoek, this very drinkable Sauvignon Blanc is delectably-dry and a very easy drinking white wine to accompany a Barristers Lunch.

### Anura - Simonsberg, Paarl (ABV 13.5%)

R90

Grown on the slopes of the Simonsberg this wine has only recently been released and represents a typical sauvignon blanc at a very reasonable price.

### Rietvallei - Robertson (ABV 12.0%)

R100

The nose of this wine reveals vibrant fruit with expressive passion fruit and grapefruit notes, freshly-cut grass and a touch of capsicum.

### Clouds - Helshoogte, Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R38 R110

Fermented cold and bottled early. The wine is crisp and fruity with vibrant gooseberry, grapefruit and tropical notes. Due to the large volume of Clouds we get through, this wine offers exceptional Barristers value.

### Sophie Te' blanche - Elgin (ABV 13.5%)

R40 R115

The most famous woman to ever exist [*sic*], and is also the nickname in South Africa for Sauvignon Blanc.

### Fat Bastard - Robertson (ABV 13.5%)

R120

This wine has a smooth, rich, toasty, lime marmalade aroma with tropical flavours and an interesting orange zest finish. Always reminds you of someone!

### Groote Post - Darling, West Coast (ABV 13.5%)

R130

Who says Sauvignon Blanc is all about acidity? Ideal growing conditions have resulted in a superbly-balanced wine, displaying characteristic freshly-mown grass on the nose and rich, luscious white peach flavours.

### Neil Ellis - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R150

Predominant flavours are those of tropical fruit with herbaceous overtones, whilst the overall impression is of elegance and delicacy with a long and flavoursome finish.

### Clos Malverne - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.0%)

R55 R155

The wine is full and dry with well-balanced acid. It has tropical fruit, flintiness, hints of asparagus and figs on the nose that all follow through to the palate.

## Sauvignon Blanc - continued

### Land's End Sauvignon Blanc - Elim, Cape Agulus (ABV 13.5%)

R155

Rich, ripe, smoky, canned pea and sea salt aromas with a full-complex green fig and peach palate and a long, crisp limey finish. The bottle makes you feel as if you are at Cape Agulus on a windy day!

### Springfield Life from Stone - Robertson (ABV 12.5%)

R160

Brilliant, greenish in appearance; this is a dramatic wine full of ripe-red peppers and passion fruit. Mineral and gun-flint flavours will develop after the first year in the bottle.

### Tokara Elgin Reserve Collection - Elgin (ABV 13.5%)

R175

Aromas of freshly-cut grass, nettles and ginger offer insight into this confident wine. Lemongrass punctuates an already heady aromatic offering.

### Groot Constantia Sauvignon Blanc - Constantia (ABV 13.5%)

R180

The most noble wine estate in all the Cape. Groot Constantia sauvignon blanc lives up to its heritage and invokes tales of the VOC through to the Cloete family. Not only an outstanding wine, but the one that is grown closest to Barristers and shares the same terroir!

### Cape Point – Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R180

Delicious, silky-textured wine, with aromas of fresh lemon, baked apple with tropical fruits on the palate, ending with a bone-dry finish.

### Iona Sauvignon Blanc – Elgin (ABV 13.5%)

R195

Strong mineral aromas with undertones of gooseberry, mango, quince and lime zest. A spicy entry, with a rich, fruit-driven mid-palate and a long, fresh grapefruit finish.

<b>Van Zylshof Riverian</b> - Bonnievale, Robertson (ABV 14.0%)	R35	R100
Brilliant with tinges of green. Fresh citrus with subtle tropical fruits. Fresh fruit, creamy palate balanced well with good acidity.		
<b>Fat Bastard</b> - Robertson (ABV 14.0%)		R125
This wine has a smooth, rich, toasty, lime marmalade aroma with tropical flavour and an interesting orange zest finish. Buy one for a soon to be ex-friend.		
<b>Groote Post</b> - Darling, West Coast (ABV 14.0%)	R45	R130
An appealing citrus and hint of lime nose with a generous palate of marmalade and preserved ginger. Its full flavours and good length with a lively acid structure makes this an ideal food wine.		
<b>Glenwood</b> - Franschhoek (ABV 13.5%)		R140
Intense layers of citrus with subtle notes of green apple on the after palate from this boutique winery.		
<b>Hartenberg</b> - Bottelary Hills, Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)		R150
Hartenberg's flagship white. creamy, complex, and bursting with aromas of citrus. Long lingering flavours with gentle oak finish.		
<b>Neil Ellis</b> - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)		R165
Tight lemony lime aromas with green apple and a touch of vanilla. Tight focused palate with citrus fruit and an elegant long finish.

## Chenin Blanc

**Robertson Chenin** - Robertson (ABV 12.5%)

R25 R70

Why it is spelt with a 'C' when pronounced as a 'Sh' beats me. Perhaps it has to do with the second glass?

**Kleine Zalze** - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R30 R85

Strong guava combined with ripe pineapples and peach aroma show on the nose and follow through to the palate. One of the most beautiful estates in the country.

**Ken Forrester Petit** - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R30 R85

Delicious silky textured wine, with aromas of fresh lemon, baked apple with tropical fruits on the palate, ending with a bone dry finish

**Waterford "Pecan Stream"** - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R35 R100

A beautiful wine with ripe melon and pear aroma. A dense layered fruit on the palate.

**L'Avenir Chenin Blanc** - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.0%)

R125

Sweet canned pineapple and fresh melon flavours. The finish is soft and smooth

## Wooded

**Spier Private Collection Chenin Blanc** - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R175

Aromas of orange peel and pear with strong undertones of vanilla. Full-bodied.

# WHITE WINES

## Blends

250ml 750ml

### **Robertson Beukett** - Robertson (ABV 10.5%)

R25 R70

From now on my personal favourite...only 10.5% ABV means this is our lightest wine on the list.

### **Pierre Jourdan Tranquille** - Franschhoek (ABV 11.5%)

R30 R85

Predominantly from the white juice of the black grape, Pinot Noir, with just a little Chardonnay added to provide that butter smooth palate. No second fermentation means a lower alcohol by volume level.

### **Groote Post Old Mans Blend** - Darling Hills (ABV 13.0%)

R90

A fruity, easy drinking wine with tropical fruit aromas and floral aromas, with light grassy notes. Finishes smooth and clean. Share with the "old man" in your life.

### **Buitenverwachting Buiten Blanc** - Constantia (ABV 12.5%)

R38 R110

This full bodied Sauvignon Blanc based blend offers a variation of fruit characters including green peppers, gooseberry, green melon with hints of tropical fruit. The classic Cape Town white wine.

### **Haute Cabrière Chardonnay Pinot Noir** - Franschhoek (ABV 12.5%)

R45 R130

Healthy fruit is exhibited clearly in its vitality and intensity with a slightly crisp acidity. Chardonnay Pinot Noir performs on the palate with a long lasting after taste. The bench mark white blend. Soft gentle and just so perfect!

## Pinot Grigio

### **Terra Del Cappel** - L'Ormarins, Franschhoek (ABV 12.5%)

R105

An elegant white wine that shows a good white fruit, lemon crisp appearance that follows through onto a palatable smooth mouth feel with a balance of acidity

### **Mount Rozier Chanel** - Stellenbosch (ABV 12.5%)

R135

Rare wine made from a 26 year old single vineyard. Straw colour, with aromas of fig and flowers; medium bodied.

## Riesling

### **Hartenberg Weisser Riesling** - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.0%)

R110

The spicy richness on the nose gives way to a taut yet floral and fruity mid-palate that has both richness and complexity

## Gewürztraminer

### **Delheim** - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R125

Classic rose and ripe litchi flavours in piquant balance. Refined, elegant with silky opulence. Haunting spicy, food friendly length. Taste the sunshine - Galileo must have been a fan of this Gewürztraminer!

# Rosé

## Dry Rosé

250ml 750ml

### L'avenir Rosé de Pinotage - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.0%)

R30 R85

An exceptionally fruity nose that is rich with raspberry and strawberry aromas yet is surprisingly dry and refreshing on the palate.

### Topiary Rose - Franschhoek (ABV 13.0%)

R95

Beautiful, delicate pink colour with a clean, crisp and dry palate and lively flowery bouquet. Bone dry!

### Clouds Sauvignon Pink - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R40 R115

Sauvignon Blanc from Clouds Vineyards is softened and flavoured by a splash of young Syrah. A gentle pink salmon colour with a unique nose contrasting the vibrancy of Sauvignon Blanc with a gentle burst of berries. The signature zest of passion fruit, gooseberries and kiwi. A great wine at an exceptional price.

### Sophie - Elgin (ABV 13.5%)

R40 R115

Apple and cherry aromas with undertones of fresh cut grass. The palate is clean and crisp with soft red fruits and a pleasingly dry finish.

## Off-Dry

### Delheim Pinotage Rosé - Stellenbosch (ABV 12.5%)

R30 R85

Intense ruby red colour. Concentrated strawberry flavours with floral tones on the nose. Wine is crisp with a refreshing finish.

### Boschendal Blanc de Noir - Franschhoek (ABV 13.5%)

R90

This combination of Pinot Noir and Shiraz imparts a lovely light salmon colour to the wine. The nose is of perfume and ripe fruit flavours, including red cherry and strawberries

# RED WINES

## Merlot

250ml Bottle

### **Robertson Merlot** - Robertson (ABV 13.5%)

R30 R85

Your dependable supply of those things in red wine that are good for you!

### **Fortress Hill** – Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R35 R95

Full flavours of red and black berries. Soft and easy on the pallet, with all the goodness of red wine.

### **Darling Cellars Reserve Six Tonner** - Darling, West Coast (ABV 14.0%)

R95

Swartland winery at its best. Bush vines that deliver a scant six tons of grape per hectare with concentrated flavours and typical merlot smoothness.

### **Spier** - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R115

More than Moya and the Spier bang-shoot. This is a wonderful merlot that truly tastes of blackcurrants and really is velvety smooth on the pallet.

### **Bellpost** - Vredendal, West Coast (ABV 14.5%)

R120

Bellpost comes from the dry Namaqualand, very close to the Vanrhynsdorp. Intense sunshine and clean water from the Olifants River give the voluptuous merlot berries the perfect balance of flavour and ensure that the sunshine is captured in this well priced merlot.

### **Glenwood** - Franschhoek (ABV 14.0%)

R135

A small family owned boutique farm in Franschhoek produces tiny volumes of top quality wines – we think so – but, judge for yourself!

### **De Grendel Merlot** – Tygerberg, Cape Town (ABV 14.5%)

R170

Founded by the first baronet Sir David Graff (1859 – 1932), De Grendel overlooks Table Bay and is distinguished by a cool growing climate, resulting in a distinctive and expressive style. Certainly the aristocrat of the cape merlots.

### **Mount Rozier Julian** - Stellenbosch (ABV 15.0%)

R170

The regular merlot plum and vanilla, aged in new French oak from grapes grown at Journey's End in the Vergellegen valley of Somerset West. A true merlot to accompany a celebration of life.

### **Boschkloof** - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.5%)

R210

No for the faint hearted. BIG tannins and 14.8% alcohol dominate gentle prune (is there such a thing?), malt and clean leather flavours – enough said.

*We others, who have long lost the more subtle of the physical senses, have not even proper terms to express an animal's inter-communications with his surroundings, living or otherwise, and have only the word 'smell,' for instance, to include the whole range of delicate thrills which murmur in the nose of the animal night and day, summoning, warning? inciting, repelling. # RED WINES

## Shiraz

250ml Bottle

### Hermit on the Hill Syrah – Paarl (ABV 14.5%)

R38 R110

Pieter de Waal strives for honesty and elegance in winemaking. His Hermit certainly delivers both of these in our most popular red wine by the glass. Garagiste wine making at its best.

### De Grendel Shiraz – Tygerberg (ABV 14.0%)

R170

True to the heritage of the Graff family farm, De Grendel lies on the south-western slopes of Tygerberg and enjoys spectacular views of the Mother City. This shiraz captures the exquisite taste and aromas of Cape Town.

### Groote Post Shiraz - Darling, West Coast (ABV 14.5%)

R170

Platter gives it 4½ stars. Who are we to argue? The perfect specimen of a typical shiraz, with all the light fruit flavours.

### Steenberg Shiraz - Constatia, Table Mountain (ABV 15.0%)

R170

Being opposite Pollsmore is no coincidence. Open a Steenberg Shiraz and the rush of escaping flavours is overwhelming. Not quite as good as their Sauvignon Blanc, but a superb shiraz, worthy of its heritage.

### Ridgeback Shiraz – Langverwacht, Paarl (ABV 13.5%)

R175

Ripe array of plums, black olives and bay-leaves with a firm backbone of mocha, mineral and smokey oak to support. Much like the Rhodesian Ridgeback – always proud and at your service.

## Pinot Noir

### Robertson Pinot Noir - Robertson (ABV 13.5%)

R35 R95

Rated the best pinot noir in its price range – delectable, light and best drunk chilled; on the deck; before 3 pm.

### De Grendel Pinot – Tygerberg, Cape Town (ABV 13.0%)

R145

The closest wine estate to the City of Cape Town. De Grendel has been in the Graaf family for 5 generations and benefits from the cool climate it enjoys on the western slopes of the Tygerberg, overlooking Table Bay.

### Paradyskloof Pinot Noir - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.0%)

R180

A medium bodied wine with dark ripe cherry on the nose and aftertaste. There are lovely, wet, earthy notes and a refreshing acidity. Only to be shared with really good friends.

### Haute Cabriere Pinot Noir – Franschhoek (ABV 13.5%)

R270

The joy of wine is to share wine intimately. In every glass of true Pinot Noir is an elegant lady to be treasured sip by sip. One glass at a time vintage by vintage, accurately recorded for always.

## Tinta Barocca

### De Krans Tinta Barocca – Calitzdorp (ABV 14.5%)

R100

Situated on Route 62 at Buffelsvlei, the first farm was established in the Calitzdorp district in 1757. The area is renown for its ports. This tinta barocca is a dry red wine with peppery aromas and a sweet balanced finish. For the record Platter gives it four stars! With curry and our masala sauce it is unbeatable.

## French

### Cotes du Rhone du Calvet - Rhone, France

R35 R100

Deep pomegranate red colour with ruby rim. Nose of chocolate, liquorice, blackberry fruits with touches of cassis. Medium rich attack on palate with warm rich in mouth flavours of red and blackberry fruits and hints of black pepper (typical of Grenache and Syrah). Elegant ripe tannins with a good acid grip and persistent aftertaste. A chance to experience French wine without the Air France bit in between!



# RED WINES

## Pinotage

250ml Bottle

## Unwooded

### Robertson Pinotage - Robertson (ABV 13.5%)

R30 R85

Somehow Pinotage used to go with herringbone tweed, briar pipes and obscure books on architecture. Now it goes with anything; as long as it has the tang of a sharp cheese, a leaf of rocket or a delectable hint of paté.

### Simonsig - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R140

Deep black cherry hue with a Persian undercoat. Voluptuous nose displaying sweet raspberry aromas intertwine with layers of delicious plum & berry fruit.

## Wooded

### Diemersfontein – Wellington (ABV 14.0%)

R165

This is the one! The original coffee/chocolate Pinotage now in its seventh vintage. It befriends - It covers - It seduces

### Clos Malverne Le Café - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R160

Prominent aromas of coffee, mocha and chocolate, with spicy undertones of cinnamon and notes of roasted coffee beans that end with a smooth lingering aftertaste. Only if you like coffee.

### Hidden Valley – Helderberg Mountains, Stellenbosch (ABV 14.5%)

R170

Big bold style with softness on palate. The estate focuses on terroir driven wines, using sustainable environment practices.

## Cabernet Sauvignon

250ml Bottle

### Robertson Cabernet Sauvignon - Robertson (ABV 13.5%)

R30 R85

Ever popular and always available at Barristers. What better way to unwind after a hard winter's eve drive from a cold day at the office en route home.

### Warwick "First Lady" - Simonsberg, Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R45 R140

This elegant wine is crafted in a sophisticated style and the "First Lady" is a tribute to Norma Ratcliff - a pioneer in the South African Wine Industry.

### Bellpost Ruby Cabernet - Vredendal, West Coast (ABV 13.5%)

R140

Ruby cabernet has such a decadent colour. Even at 54 I still blush when I drink it. Voluptuous and uplifting.

### L'Avenir - Stellenbosch (ABV 13.5%)

R165

Typical claret with spicy cigar box - leathery nose followed by intense flavours of cassis and blackcurrant

### Springfield "Whole Berry" - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R195

A velvety wine with softer tannins and classical varietal characteristics due to the maceration of the whole berry and gravity feeding the fermentation into oak barrels for one year. Barristers best and smoothest.

### Waterford - Stellenbosch (ABV 14.0%)

R255

First class example of modern but classically reminiscent cabernet.

## Cabernet Franc

### Hermanuspietersfontein (HPF) Swartskaaap - Hermanus (ABV 14.0%)

R325
